



The financial statements of the Wayne County Community Foundation are audited by a Certified Public Accountant. The audited financial statements, including the auditor's report and notes to the financial statements, as well as the most recently filed IRS Form 990, are on file at the Foundation's office and are available on the Foundation's website.

Our investments are managed by five financial institutions: The Dime Bank, The Honesdale National Bank, Wayne Bank, Morgan Stanley and a new ESG (Environmental, social, and corporate governance) focused portfolio managed by CornerStone Asset Management. CornerStone Asset Management also helps act as Chief Investment Officers for the Foundation and their staff work closely with the local representatives at the other four institutions to communicate a comprehensive view of our investment portfolios. Our investment committee, made up of Foundation board members, meets five times a year; once with each investment partner.

The Wayne County Community Foundation is a 501(c)3 nonprofit, tax-exempt organization. EIN 23-2656896

#### DESCRIPTION OF CHARITABLE FUNDS

With the Wayne County Community Foundation, it's easy to leave your legacy with the community you care about. Each of our funds have a very modest 1% fee yearly to the foundation for managing your assets and donations and expenses of the fund. We can help you create a charitable fund in three simple steps.

- **1. Give it a name.** The name of the fund can be in memory of a loved one, a field of interest you're passionate about supporting or your family name.
- **2. Give it a purpose.** What matters most to you that you want to address in our community? We can work with you to establish a fund that will help achieve your charitable goals.
- **3. Give it support.** Offer your own tax-deductible donations now or through your estate and/or share with your friends, family and colleagues to support the fund.

#### WHAT KIND OF CHARITABLE FUNDS DO WE HAVE?

**Donor-advised Funds:** You can stay actively involved in the distribution of dollars from this fund by establishing a donor-advised fund. You recommend grants and the size of the grant to charitable organizations of your choosing. These funds can be endowed or quasi-endowed.

**Endowment Funds:** You can establish an endowment fund to benefit one or more organizations you determine, but only spend from the principal of the fund (usually 3-4% yearly). This is a great way to continue annual giving in perpetuity.

**Field of Interest Funds:** Support nonprofit organizations within a general area of interest such as youth programming, literacy, animal welfare, arts, and culture, or a specific geographic region of Wayne County.

**Organizational Funds:** An organizational fund is a type of esignated fund that is created by a nonprofit organization with the goal of it lasting into the future, while having the flexibility to serve the organization's more pressing needs when they arise. It's the best of both worlds.

**Scholarship Funds:** The Community Foundation manages a variety of scholarship funds ranging from those that support college studies for outgoing seniors in high school to furthering education in trades and certificate programs or master's degree programs.

**Wayne Tomorrow! Fund:** The Wayne Tomorrow! Fund supports strategic, county-wide initiatives that will effectively address and reverse certain trends the county has been observing, including poverty, housing, transportation issues, and agricultural needs.




## BUILDING HOME LIBRARIES

With our book purchase from Scholastic we collected hundreds of additional books to keep the Little Free Libraries in Wayne County stocked all year and the Honesdale Rotary even distributed dozens of books at the Jaycees Halloween parade in 2021!

## EDUCATION PROGRAMS

#### THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) was created through a generous bequest of Eleanor Ferro and the Foundation in order to familiarize Wayne County High School students with philanthropy and grantmaking. Students in grades 9-12 participate in the committee and accept mini-grant applications and work together to decide how the funds are distributed.

In the past year, the **YAC** made mini grants totaling **\$6000** to Wallenpaupack Area School District, Wayne Highlands and Western Wayne School Districts and to the Wayne County Arts Alliance.

## EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT TAX CREDIT PROGRAM (EITC)

The Wayne County Community Foundation acts as a conduit to support highly academic innovative and challenging STEM programs and dual enrollment programs at Johnson College at Wayne Highlands, Wallenpaupack, Western Wayne, and Forest City Regional School District. This year, a total of \$90,500 was donated by The Dime Bank, PPL Foundation, The Honesdale National Bank, NBT Bank, FNCB Bank, Waste Management, Weis Markets, and the First National Bank of Pennsylvania to support the program.



The Wayne County Community Foundation participates actively in the Wayne Tomorrow! Initiative. In 2019, we established a Wayne Tomorrow! Fund at the foundation to be able to accept charitable donations to support Wayne Tomorrow! activities and to be a fiscal agent for future grant applications.

Wayne Tomorrow! is a broad, county-sponsored, community-based collaboration focused on the projects, resources, and infrastructure needed to move Wayne County, its people, its culture and its economy into a vibrant future.

It's not an entity, it's a partnership and a way of operating. This type of collaboration takes a commitment to the common goals and a willingness to focus on "we" not "me"!

The fund seeks to build a robust, multi-dimensional economic and cultural ecosystem that will effectively address and reverse certain negative trends the county has been observing, including poverty, transportation issues, and agricultural needs. This ecosystem will be the foundation for ensuring improved conditions are achieved and maintained into the future, in spite of facing new challenges and a constantly changing landscape.

- The Foundation has the funding required to support the project




WAHS AVIATION CLUB



## 2021 Ben Franklin Community Service Award —Henry Skier

#### WHAT IS THE BEN FRANKLIN FUND?

In his will, Benjamin Franklin wrote, "I wish to be useful even after my death." When he died in 1790, he left £2,000 (the equivalent of about \$354,000 in 2022) in a trust fund to be specifically used and saved for 200 years. In keeping with Franklin's philosophy, the Pennsylvania General Assembly directed the perpetual "Ben Franklin Trust" be established and that the interest be used to benefit the citizens of the Commonwealth. On December 17th, 1990, Governor Robert P. Casey signed Act 1990-173 into law, approving the then sum of \$834,000 to be distributed to Community Foundations in Pennsylvania, including the Wayne County Community Foundation which received nearly \$20,000 in 1995.

Each year, a member (or members) from our community is selected for their positive impact on the betterment of Wayne County. Henry Skier, the Foundation's 2021 Ben Franklin Community Service Award recipient, was honored on July 10th, 2022 at Harmony in the Woods with a short ceremony and a great concert. The outdoor event drew over 120 guests who came out to support Henry and enjoy the beautiful weather and toe-tapping show by Pete Muller and the Kindred Souls.

Henry Skier serves as President of AMSkier Insurance and AMSkier Reinsurance. After receiving his early education in Honesdale, Henry went on to pursue higher education at Syracuse University and Temple Law School. Prior to returning to Hawley, Pennsylvania to lead the family business, Henry served as a Captain in the United States Army.

Founded in 1920 by Henry's father, Abe Skier, AMSkier Insurance is entering its 101st year as the largest insurer and reinsurer of children's camps in the United States. Carrying on his father's legacy, Henry has devoted his professional life to making the camp experience fun, safe, and accessible to children across the country.

Attributing AMSkier's success to his father's dedication to hard work, personal relationships, and giving back, Henry is committed to cultivating relationships and fostering strategic partnerships. This has led to his involvement in numerous philanthropic initiatives helping children and young adults from underserved communities access life-changing, overnight summer camp experiences.

Henry is married to Eve Skier and shares leadership in AMSkier with his two children Jeffrey and Aimee Skier. He is also the proud grandfather of Annie, Abe, and Slater.
